2. Develop a Birth-3 Program

"A child's brain develops faster from birth-to-agethree than at any later period in life, building the foundation for all future learning, behavior, and health." (BUILD, 2020)

Rationale:

- Better Lifelong learning outcomes for infants
- Break the "cycle"
- Retention of teen parents and teachers
- Promoting parent-baby bonds (breastfeeding, skin-to-skin, check-ins)
- *Important Clarification: This program is to support teen parents. It is not meant to encourage sexual behavior and/or conception. We already have teen pregnancy in the valley. Addressing this issue will increase teen-parent academic success, infant success, and wellness for both mother and baby.
